- 1) A recreation pass is required to use the ATV trails. Each pass must be visibly affixed to your ATV.

The following passes will be available:

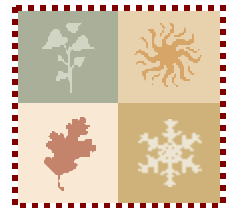
- 2) **What is an ATV?**




An all-terrain vehicle means any motor vehicle for off-road use, which is fifty (50) inches or less in width; has a dry weight of 600 lbs. or less; travels on three (3) or more low pressure tires; is designed for operator use only with no passengers; and has a seat or saddle designed to be straddled by the operator, and handle bars for steering control.

- 3) **Seasonal Closure**

The ATV trails will be closed beginning December 1 and ending April 30 annually. This is considered the wet time of year and maintenance will be done during this time.



- 4) Only ATVs are allowed to operate on designated trails with one exception, pedestrian foot travel will be allowed during the closed season (December 1 to April 30).

- 5)  ATVs can **ONLY** be operated on designated routes. A designated route is a road or trail, which has been identified by a posted orange diamond along the route. If you do not see an orange diamond, it is not a designated route, and you are subject to criminal prosecution if you are found operating off a designated route.

- 6) The area is closed after 10:00 p.m. for ATVs and / or other vehicles.
